



\*What does it mean for a problem to be "mine" or "yours"?

- If my reaction is extreme in its intensity and/or my reaction seems random and/or no one but me seems to be bothered by *your annoying behavior*, it's likely that "the problem" is mine.
- If, on the other hands, lots of people are bothered by *your annoying habit*, and/or it violates some clear standard for good behavior that's widely accepted in our community, the problem is potentially yours.
